Serval wildlife is a wildlife sanctuary like no other. Unlike the traditional methods of viewing wildlife such as game drives or hot air balloon safaris this experience allows you to approach the wildlife by foot with a local guide. You get an opportunity to get up close and personal with animals by feeding them, petting them and taking pictures with them in a carefully monitored way that is trusted and with experienced keepers that prioritize safety.



Several wildlife is located in the Kilimanjaro area of Siha District close to Mount Kilimanjaro and is the only upmarket eco-tourism positioned in Kilimanjaro. You will see a perfectly managed ecosystem with over 3000 hand-planted unique varieties of flora and the view of Mount Kilimanjaro and Mount Meru as you traverse the sanctuary's picturesque landscape. Throughout the day, you'll have the opportunity to participate in guided walks to see a variety of animals currently living in the sanctuary including: Lions, Giraffes, Zebras, Wildebeest, kudu, birds and more all while being surrounded by the sights and sounds of the African wilderness.



You will have an hour to spend with the wildlife, where you can:

- ▶ Feed them
- ▶ Take their picture
- ▶ Pet them

MAASAI VILLAGE

Also referred to as Kambi ya Chokaa is an authentic village founded by the local Maasai. During this visit, will have a chance to mingle with the Maasai and chat with them, but your social skills and creativity will determine how much they open up to you.

Your guide will assist you to navigate around them, as the Maasai themselves do not speak any other languages expect KiMaasai (their local language). Whilst you walk through the village with your guide, you will learn more about the culture of the Maasai, a lesson on traditional Maasai medicine and the opportunity to taste the local Maasai tea.



KIKULETWA HOT SPRINGS

Also known as Maji Moto and also Chemka Hot Springs, is a natural geothermal oasis. Chemka means "boiling" in Swahili, referring to the appearance of how the water emerges from the ground. The hot spring waters flow into the Kikuletwa River and eventually find its way to the Pangani River.

The crystal clear, turquoise waters invite you for a refreshing swim. Although called a hot spring, water in Kikuletwa is not hot, but rather refreshing since the water source is from the Kilimanjaro Mountain itself.

After enjoying a swim, we will have a picnic lunch and relax, then we return to Moshi.

Location

Located in Masama Rundugai ward of Hai District in the Kilimanjaro region of Tanzania. The hot springs are located approximately 40 kilometers from the town of Moshi, which is a gateway to Mount Kilimanjaro in a village called Chemka.

Attraction

The Kikuletwa Hot Springs are certainly one of the most beautiful places in Tanzania - the hot springs are surrounded by fig and palm trees and winding roots - a real hidden paradise. It is also surrounded by various bird species and vegetation of which mostly dominated by hyphaene species. The Maasai village visit and experiences.



This charming place is just 15km away from Moshi Town and it is the last village before the Kilimanjaro National Park. Materuni waterfall is found around Kilimanjaro National Park, and is one of the tallest waterfalls measuring 70m to its basin. This charming village of Materuni, home to the Chagga people is also renowned for its rich and aromatic coffee.




Overview

On this tour, your guide will take you on an unforgettable waterfall and coffee tour. Transportation will leave from the hotel and your day will start with visiting a coffee plantation, where you will learn how coffee is cultivated, harvested, and processed. Practice roasting, brew your own cup of coffee the traditional way and learn the secret to the perfect blend from the locals and get to know the culture of the indigenous Chagga tribe.

Your adventure will continue with a hike to Materuni Waterfalls, it is the tallest and most magnificent waterfall at the base of Mount Kilimanjaro. Here you can stand under the cascading waters as they flow into a serene pool. Remember to pack your swimwear, as you will also get a chance to cool off with a refreshing swim and to explore the gorgeous, lush surroundings! Lunch and entry costs are included in the price of the tour. Here there's no set agenda, just pure relaxation and then a drive back to the hotel.

Attractions

Materuni waterfall is the main attraction; however, there are other attractions such as the coffee plantation, botanical gardens, Chagga culture, scenic view of the area, birds, and some animals such as colobus monkeys.

At Materuni waterfall activities may include Swimming, hiking, coffee tour bird watching, photographing and traditional brew.
